NATIONAL CHILD MEASUREMENT PROGRAMME

NELFT Redbridge 0-19 Children's Universal Services (who work as part of the NHS) will shortly be coming to our school to measure children's height and weight of pupils in Reception and in Year 6.

If you have a child in Reception or Year 6 you will receive a letter with information to explain about this in advance of when the measurements are taken.

Result letters are sent out to parents approximately 6 weeks after the measurements have been taken.

If attached to your results letter you receive an invite to a healthy lifestyle session we encourage you to attend.



To mark the centenary of the end of the First World War on Remembrance Sunday in November, the Leader of Redbridge Council, Cllr Jas Athwal wants the Redbridge Community to create a display of thousands of knitted poppies which will adorn the front of the Town Hall in Ilford.

People are being asked to knit a simple and basic Red and Black poppy which will be placed on netting and displayed on the Town Hall balconies to commemorate the 100th Centenary since the end of the Great War. Further information will be available on www.redbridge.gov.uk in the next few days.

The poppies are being collected at Redbridge Town Hall until 31st October and the display will be installed during the week prior to Remembrance Sunday.
