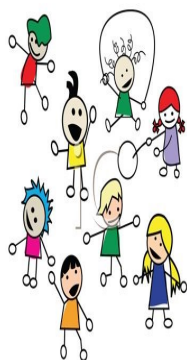

## School Council

Members of the School Council visited Anchor House in Canning Town to distribute our Harvest Festival donations. During their visit, they met residents and questioned them to find out more about the charity and the work it does to support homeless people.
