GOSPEL REFLECTION

Gospel: Matthew 16:13-19

In Sunday's Gospel we hear how the disciple Simon recognises Jesus as the Messiah and how Jesus gives Simon a new name (Peter). Jesus tells Peter that he will build his church on him.

Jesus asks the disciples who people say he is. The disciples say that people think Jesus might be John the Baptist, Elijah, Jeremiah or one of the prophets. Then Jesus asks the disciples who they believe he is.

Simon says that Jesus is the Son of God. He believes in Jesus and he is not afraid to say so. Jesus gives Simon a new name – Peter. And Jesus tells Simon Peter that he will have the keys to the kingdom of heaven.

Simon Peter was just an ordinary fisherman with his brother Andrew. But he was one of the first disciples of Jesus.

Jesus gave Simon the name *Peter* which means *rock* in Greek. Jesus wanted to build his Church on strong ground and rock is a strong material. Simon Peter's faith was strong here, like a rock, so Peter was a good name for him! Peter is one of the greatest leaders of the early Church.

Simon Peter believed in Jesus. He wanted to follow him and serve him, and in this story he spoke up about what he believed.

Simon Peter can inspire us in our own life; we can be strong in your faith and speak up for what we believe in.
