#### GOSPEL REFLECTION

Luke 18: 9-14

In last Sunday's Gospel, we hear about the Pharisee who goes to the Temple to pray, he is full of pride, he thinks he is brilliant, that he has done everything right and that God must love him very much. A tax collector comes to pray and is humble and ashamed; he knows he has done wrong and he asks God for forgiveness. Jesus wanted the Pharisee and us, to understand that the things we say when we pray are not as important as what is in our hearts, what we are thinking and feeling deep down.

The Pharisee thought that the way to enter God's kingdom was by keeping a lot of rules and making new rules. The Pharisee thought that all the people who did not keep their rules were bad and unacceptable to God. The two men behaved very differently in the temple that day; the Pharisee was proud and thought he was better than other people.

The tax collector knew that he was no better than anyone else and that only God could give him the forgiveness and mercy he needed. However, we are all equal in the eyes of God, who loves us all. No matter whom we are where we come from, the colour of our skin, whether we are rich or poor, tall or short, we are special in God's eyes. God loves us all very much.

The class winners for the best attendance last week was: 2B, 5S, 6R with 100%


The class which needs to improve most: 6B for attendance of 90.83%


Best punctuality: RS with 1 late mark.
